KIWE, compatible with all TCP/IP Internet connections, is an economical solution to an expanding set of issues of serious concern to parents, educators and government interests.

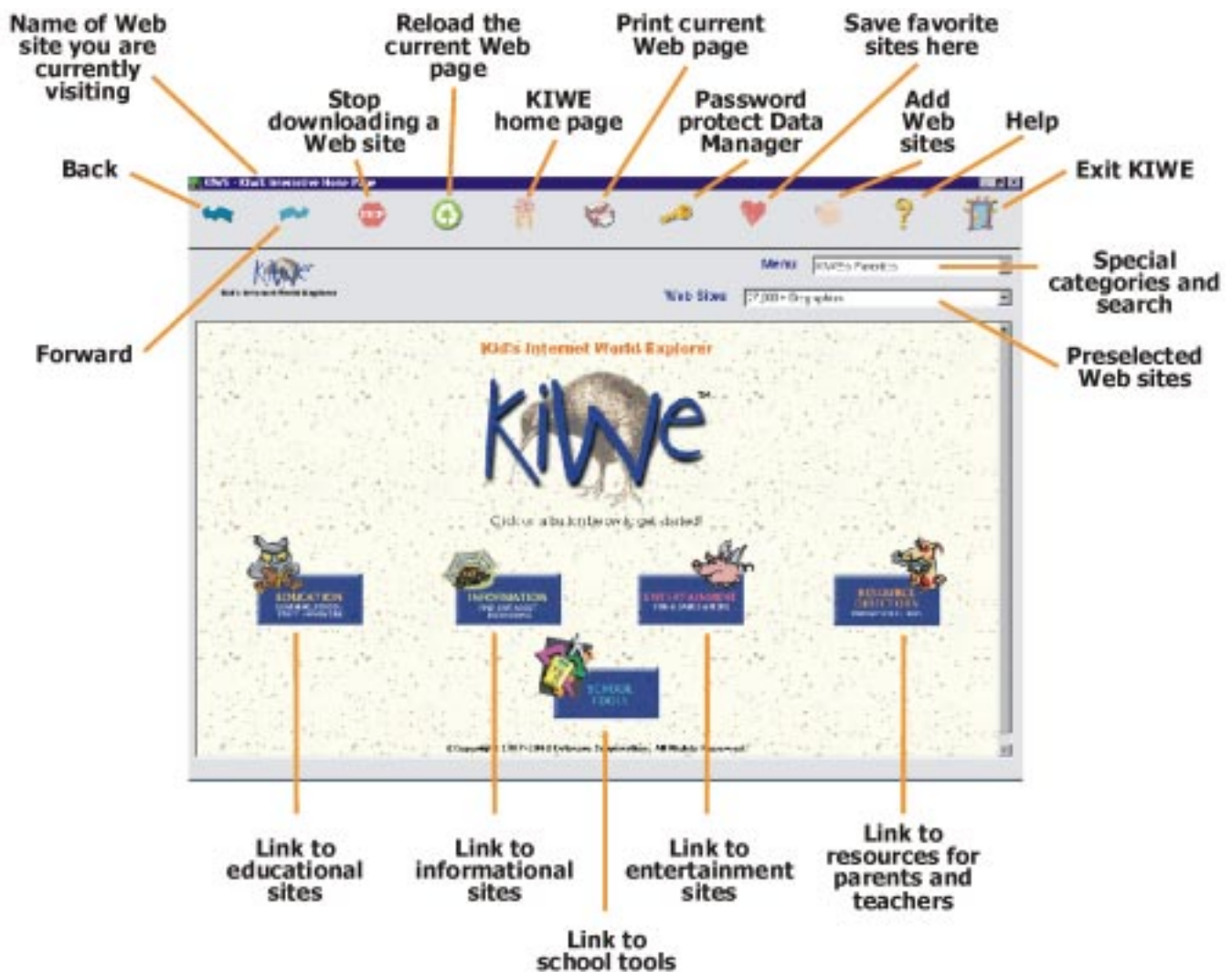
